

# **CARROLL ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP CORPORATION**

## **SCHEDULE NEC-1 NUCLEAR ENERGY CERTIFICATE RATE RIDER**

### **AVAILABILITY**

Available in all territory served by the Corporation in accordance with the Service Rules and Regulations of the Corporation on file with the Georgia Public Service Commission.

### **APPLICABILITY**

Applicable to all active Corporation accounts served under the Large Power (LP) rate schedule. Nuclear Energy Certificates (NECs) are limited and will only be available while NECs exist and are to be purchased on a first-come, first-served basis. All NECs sold under this schedule will be retired by the Corporation in the name of the subscribing Corporation member.

### **TYPE OF SERVICE**

The service offered is for the transfer of available NECs to a subscribing Corporation member for up to a maximum of 100% of their monthly energy usage. In no case shall the Corporation sell a subscribing Corporation member more NECs than needed to cover a member's monthly energy usage with the Corporation. For Corporation members purchasing both NECs and renewable energy certificates (RECs), total certificates purchased cannot exceed 100% of monthly usage.

### **RATE PER MONTH**

NECs will be sold to qualifying Corporation members as outlined below:

1. **\$3.75** per NEC (\$0.00375 per kWh) and shall represent only the environmental attributes of 1,000 kilowatt-hours (one megawatt-hour) of electricity generated by nuclear
2. The fees for the purchase of NECs will be added to the rate schedule assigned to the member's account

### **TERMS OF CONTRACT**

Service under this rate shall be for a period of one (1) month. The Corporation reserves the right to terminate any and all sales under this rate at the Corporation's discretion.

### **TERMS OF PAYMENT**

All bills are net and payable according to the provisions stated in the contract for service between the Corporation and the member.

## **TAXES**

In addition, the Consumer will pay the amount of any sales, use, franchise or utility taxes for charges now or hereafter applicable to or arising out of the service rendered or made available under this schedule, which tax shall be added to each bill; unless the Consumer furnishes satisfactory evidence that it is exempt here from.
